SUBJECT: Cost-of-Living Adjustment
Effective September 1, 1978

DATE: April 10, 1978

As you are aware, county officials are once again due a salary adjustment on September 1, 1978, which reflects the percentage increase in the average consumer price index for 1977 over 1976. This will be the last such increase for county officials due to legislation passed during the first session of the 90th General Assembly.

The new cost-of-living increase will be 6.5% effective September 1, 1978, and is shown in the attached schedules for most county officials. The tables show present salary, salary effective September 1 and the fiscal year 1978-79 salary for budgetary purposes.


