County Highway OfficialMinimum Salary - Provided for by T.C.A. 54-7-106 Fiscal Year 1983-84

The county highway official's minimum salary cannot be less than the salary of the county clerk (T.C.A. 54-7-106). The schedules below use the maximum and minimum base salaries of the county clerk to calculate the highway officials minimum salary (T.C.A. 8-24-102 and 8-24-104).
